

## SET-UP/TAKE DOWN INSTRUCTIONS FOR FIELDS THAT REQUIRE ATTENTION

The following information is provided as a central location for teams who need set-up and/or take down instructions for the field at which they are playing for State Cup. In some instances

Note: If you do not see the field you are playing on listed, it is your lucky day – the club/park authority who is offering the field is providing all required set-up and take down.

| Bles Park                           | ASC         | Home teams for EACH game must provide their own corner flags. This is a grass field so flags with spikes are needed.   |
| Chinn – all fields                  | PWSI        | The 1 <sup>st</sup> and last HOME teams must set-up and take down, respectively. Set-up includes nets and flags. Both are located in the large brown field box between Fields 1 & 2 by the electrical equipment cage. Contact Cathy Mann ( <a href="mailto:cathymann@aol.com">cathymann@aol.com</a> or 703-447-0139) for the combo to the box. |
| Lake Fairfax #4 - turf              | GRFL        | Home teams for EACH game must provide their own corner flags. This is a TURF field so flags must be the ones with a weighted base – you cannot use flags with spikes.  |
| Long Park 6                         | VSA         | Field 6 is a convertible field. Depending on the game scheduled immediately preceding the first state cup game of the day, the HOME team may need to move the small goals off the field for large game play. If the flags are missing – you will find them in the shed in the parking lot.   |
| Marshall High School – Stadium Turf | VYS         | No set up. Last HOME team has take down. This team must contact Erin Tesch for the lock combination and take down procedures. | Nike Park                           | GRFL        | HOME teams for EACH game must provide their own corner flags. This is a grass field so flags with spikes are needed.   |
| St. Stephens/St. Agnes              | ABGC        | Goals must be rolled from the storage area on the North side of the field into position by the set-up team, and returned to the shed by the take down  |

|               |      | team. Nets are pre-attached to the goals. Weight bags (4 per goal) and corner flags will be delivered to the field by ABGC grounds staff and picked up following the last game if game is with teams outside of ABGC. If ABGC is playing in the first/last game they will bring the bags and flags and return them to storage. |
| Tyrell        | PWSI | First home team must go across the road to the brown box and take the nets, Velcro, and flags to their field and set-up. The last team must take down the nets, Velcro, and flags and put them back in the brown box.  |
| Valley View   | NVSC | First team sets up; last team takes down. Nets and flags are located in the shed behind the concession stand.  |
| Vinyard       | RKE  | Move goals on and off the field.   |
| Word of Grace | LOUD | Only the flags need to be set-up and taken down. The flags are located in the shed to the left of the field. If a combo is needed, LOUD will provide.  |
