MINORS | U.S. CITIZEN RETURNING TO THE UNITED STATES ALONE

Application criteria:

- Player is between the ages of 10 and 17 at the time of registration
- The player is a United States citizen
- The player is returning to the United States to play with an affiliated , U.S. based club
- The parents of the minor have <u>lived continuously in the United States</u> for over a year while the player was abroad

FIFA REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Documents must be in English, Spanish, German, or French
 - Official notarized translation required with the original document if not in one of the above listed languages

- All in PDF format and no larger than 5MB
- Application must contain current and accurate information
- Applications must be submitted a minimum of 30 days prior to official start of club/league play

NOTE - Submitting at least 30 days prior to the start of official club/team/league play does not guarantee the player will be eligible as process times vary based on clearance type requesting and information submitted.

STATUS UPDATES

The Player Status Department will contact applicants to provide updates on applications when available and/or as required throughout the process. Player Status will not respond to emails which solely request a status update of submitted application due to the high volume of applications received.
